I am a Clallam County resident (and voter) and I would like you to tell Commissioner Franz to put the sale of the timber sites Power Plant and TCB23 on hold when this decision comes before the DNR on June 6th.

These sites are in a critical location, adjacent to or above the Elwha River, which is the watershed area that Washington State has invested over \$320 million dollars in. Now, the restoration of salmon access up the Elwha and its tributaries is a crucial, ongoing project. The Power Plant and TCB23 forests are part of the watershed that feeds directly into the Elwha River.

There are other logging methods and sustainable forestry practices that must be considered. Please urge a pause to this sale.
